



# Urangan Point State School

## Literate Futures



Dear Parent/Guardian

In 2019 Urangan Point State School will operate a Student Resource Scheme for all year levels Prep to Year 6.

Parents are invited to pay an annual fee which covers the cost of all key learning activities as well as consumables required by their child for that year. Some equipment, such as textbooks and maths equipment will be available for students to use but will remain the property of Urangan Point State School to be used in future years.

The cost of the Student Resource Scheme for 2019 is \$140.00 per child.

The advantages of joining this Scheme include:

- Students have all equipment necessary to begin learning from the start of the school year
- Students have immediate access to replacement items
- Students have the same items, which reduces the risk of jealousy, theft, swapping, etc
- The school purchases quality items in bulk, thereby reducing the cost to parents
- No additional costs to participate in HPE activities including swimming lessons and Gala Days. As swimming is part of the curriculum, refunds for any missed lessons will only be given for medical reasons. Presentation of a doctor's medical certificate will be required.

The cost of this Scheme will be calculated on a pro rata basis for students who enrol later in the year ie students who enrol at the beginning of Term 2 will only pay for 3 terms. Should a student leave during the year a refund of the Resource Scheme payment will be given on a pro rata basis. Refund applications are available from the school office.

**Families who choose not to participate in the Scheme will be issued with a booklist and will need to purchase all items – including textbooks, dictionaries, maths equipment - and replacements throughout the year. They will also be required to pay full cost of all HPE activities.**

This Resource Scheme does not include the cost of activities such as Arts Council presentations, instrumental music, camps, etc.

**Please note: Due to changes in the Student Resource Scheme guidelines a school hat will no longer be included in the scheme. However, school hats do remain part of the Urangan Point State School uniform and can be purchased from the school office.**

If you wish to join the Scheme please complete the attached Participation Agreement Form and return it to the school office.

Payment may be made by cash, cheque and EFTPOS at the school office. Centrepay deductions can also be arranged through the school office. Parents and carers can now make payments using BPOINT via any computer or Smart phone, Visa and Mastercard accepted visit <https://www.bpoint.com.au/payments/dete>, enter the details found on the bottom of the invoice.

**We cannot accept payments by BPAY.**

While we prefer full payment, we acknowledge that this is not possible for some families. To negotiate a payment plan with the Principal, please complete the appropriate section of the attached Parent/Carer Consent Form. We will then issue a payment agreement with your invoice.
